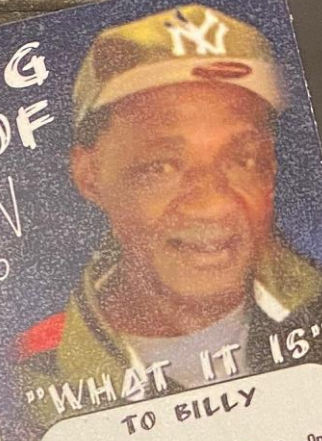


# CELEBRATING THE LIFE OF WILLIAM HORN

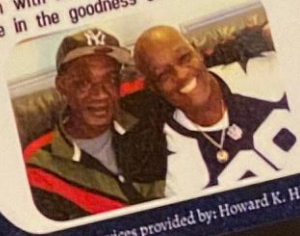
